

Top 10 Most Asked Questions

How much is rent?

Rent is based on 30% of your income and assets.

What is included in the rent?

Rent includes heat, electric, water, and garbage pickup

How big are the apartments?

The apartments are approximately 500 square feet. All are one bedroom. They include a living room, dining area, kitchen, bath and bedroom.

Do I bring my own furniture?

All apartments have a stove, refrigerator and garbage disposal. It is the tenant's responsibility to provide all other furnishings.

What kind of facilities are available?

The following facilities are available for use: Laundry Room, Lounge, and Arts and Crafts Room. Dining Centers at Antler Arms and Maple Manor, Beaverton Manor lunch is served at nearby Community Center (Lunch is provided Monday- Friday at a suggested donation). Organized activities are also available.

Are other services available to aid with housekeeping or personal care?

Yes. There are several programs offered such as Council on Aging and City County Transit, providing transportation throughout the county.

Is cable television available?

Cable hookup is available at tenant's own cost.

If something goes wrong, who fixes it?

If something in your apartment is not working properly, contact the office so we can report it to the Maintenance Department for repair.

Are vacancies currently available?

You can call and ask the Occupancy Specialist if she currently has availabilities. If there is no availability at the time, you can be placed on a waiting list.
